Cardiopulmonary services at Atrium Health Navicent Baldwin offer a variety of tests that may be ordered by your physician. All testing is supervised or interpreted by board-certified specialist physicians. Testing offered includes:

- Arterial blood gas analysis
- Ambulatory cardiac monitoring (holter, event)
- Cardiac stress testing
- Carotid arterial ultrasound
- Echocardiography examination
- Electrocardiogram (EKG)
- Lower arterial extremity screening
- Pulmonary function testing (PFT)
- Sputum induction
- TB skin testing
- Electroencephalogram (EEG)

Information provided by these tests can help your physician to diagnose or optimize treatment for disorders affecting the heart, respiratory or circulatory system. Your physician will provide specific pre-testing preparation instructions.

Respiratory therapists are on duty 24/7 to provide inpatient and outpatient care.
